CHELSEA FILM FESTIVAL ANNOUNCES ITS 2016 FEATURE FILM LINEUP

Chelsea, NY — The Chelsea Film Festival is releasing the list of films that are selected at this year's edition. Twenty-three feature-length films and documentaries have been selected in the 2016 Official Lineup.

Eight countries are represented this year : Argentina, Bolivia, France, Ireland, Iran, Germany, United States, United Kingdom.
