**Chelsea, NY** — The 11th Annual Edition of Chelsea Film Festival (CFF) announces its TV Series and Pilots program. **17 Indie Episodics** have been selected in the 2023 Official Lineup **and are in competition for the CFF Indie Episodics Award.**

**20 countries** are represented this year: France, Guadeloupe, Martinique, Bulgaria, Taiwan, Haiti, Israel, United Kingdom, Denmark, Turkey, China, Italy, Estonia, Mexico, Spain, Canada, Brazil, Cuba, Puerto Rico and The United States.
